IN COMPLIANCE WITH DEP REGULATIONS**

FLOURIDE ADDITION 2.0mg/L and under 2/10/2026-2/21/2026

FLOURIDE REMOVED ONCE RETURNED TO OUR OWN WATER SUPPLY AS OF 2/22/2026

MAXATAWNY TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY had an incident 2/9/2026 that resulted in a total water loss.

We needed to **EMERGENTLY** provide water to residents of BOWERS.

The water provided was treated with fluoride **under 2.0 mg/L**, which is the standard for fluoride.

THIS IS NOT AN EMERGENCY.

This is a notice is being issued to comply with an Emergency Permit issued by DEP.

HEALTH INFORMATION

At low levels, fluoride can help prevent cavities, but children drinking water containing more than 2 mg per liter (mg/L) of fluoride may develop discoloration of their permanent teeth (dental fluorosis). Dental fluorosis, in its moderate or severe forms, may result in brown staining or pitting of the permanent teeth, before they erupt from the gums. Drinking water containing more than 4mg/L of fluoride (the US Environmental Protection Agency's drinking water standard) can increase your risk of developing bone disease.

RECOMMEDED ACTIONS

Please share this information with people who drink this water, especially those who may not have received this notice directly (for example people in apartment, nursing homes, schools and businesses). You can do this my posing in public place or distributing by hand or mail.
